**Supplies:** Tracing paper (to copy the pattern in your size); scissors; rotary cutter, ruler & mat; pins (& weights); pressing cloth; ballpoint and/or stretch needle; thread

**Suggested Knit Fabrics:** Cotton, poly, blends with lycra. Fabrics with less stretch may require a larger size and fabrics with more stretch may require a smaller size. Make a sample garment.
